



Introduction to Theatre

This year-long, activity-oriented course is designed to introduce students to the art of Theatre and ALL that goes into creating it!

We do some lip synchs, we learn about falling techniques, and stage fighting. We do some scene work and monologues. We learn about blocking, costumes, and a whole bunch of other topics. Plus, we get to be involved with the stage productions here at the Creek – whether it’s on stage, or behind the curtains!

There is very little homework for this class, but students will help in various ways to support program productions. Therefore, there are a lot of in-class projects and activities. There’s never a dull moment in the Theatre!

All this, plus, Theatre 1 fulfills the CA State Standards for the Visual & Performing Arts as well as the VAPA requirements for graduation from BCHS and entrance to the UC/CSU system!
